
### PROVENCE DIAMARINE - £6.75 (175ml) / £27.95 (btl)

## 10 WHITES

Wine a little, it'll make you feel better

### EXHIBIT WHITE - £5 GLASS (175ml)/£20 (btl)

#### CHENIN BLANC - £5 GLASS (175ml)/£20 (btl)

Aloe Tree, SA. Tropical and fruity, this dry wine is super easy drinking for sessions in the sun.

#### FALANGHINA - £5 GLASS (175ml)/£20 (btl)

Guardiense, Italy. Light bodied, mineral and crisp. A zesty finish makes that glass go in a flash.

#### VERDEJO - £7.5 GLASS (175ml)/£30 (btl)

Vega de la Reina, Spain. A great wine to have with light meals. Crisp and bouncy, it has features of melon and lemony greenery.

#### PICPOUL DE PINET - £7.5 GLASS (175ml)/£30 (btl)

Domaine Les Ronces, France. An easy-drinking dry white, with apple and pear as the predominant aromas and flavours. Light bodied and a great acidity makes for a refreshing and crisp summer sipper.

#### SAUVIGNON BLANC - £7.5 GLASS (175ml)/£30 (btl)

Mayfly, New Zeland. A classic crowdpleaser, bursting with fruit flavours and acidity. Made by one of NZ's leading wine families its quality is assured.

## 11 WHITES (BOTTLE)

### PECORINO - £24

Terre di Chieti, Vila dei Fiori, Italy. A dry, medium bodied wine with floral aromas of Orange blossom and honeyed citrus. Crisp green apple flavours make for a refreshing glass of liquid sunshine.

### VINHO VERDE - £27

Casa do Homem, Portugal. Portugal's favourite summer wine. Crisp and delicate floral notes and a little fizz match perfectly with seafood.

### CHARDONNAY - £23

Tooma River, Australia. Full bodied white that's full of vibrant grapefruit, melon and lime. Finishes off with a zesty crisp finish.

### RIESLING - £29

Jean Biecher, France. This dry white wine is characterised by an intense freshness. It has aromas and flavours of citrus fruit, intertwined with more tropical fruit notes of peach and melon. A medium-bodied wine, with a rich and creamy texture.

## 12 RED

All you need is love and red wine, mostly red wine

### EXHIBIT RED - £5 GLASS (175ml)/£20 (btl)

#### MERLOT - £5 GLASS (175ml)/£20 (btl)

La Poeta, Italy. Intense ruby red colour with a wonderfully fruity nose and loads of red currant and black cherry fruits. Just the right hint of herbaceousness to keep this wine balanced.

#### SHIRAZ - £5 GLASS (175ml)/£20 (btl)

Aloe Tree, SA. Soft and yet spicy, this is a classic new world shiraz. Goes great with a burger.

#### RIOJA GARNACHA - £7.5 GLASS (175ml)/£30 (btl)

Finca Manzanos, Spain. An unusual Rioja made from 100% Garnacha, but hugely drinkable with soft spice and packed with fruit.

#### PINOT NOIR - £7.5 GLASS (175ml)/£30 (btl)

Santa Macarena, Chile. If you're not already sold on its beautiful label, it's freshness, red fruit profile and drinkability make it a must.

#### MALBEC - £7.5 GLASS (175ml)/£30 (btl)

Tilia, Argentina. Plum, blackberry and dark chocolate flavours are persistent from the initial taste all through the finish. A hint of pepper and spice make a Malbec that is not just your average fruit bomb.

## 13 RED (BOTTLE)

### PASSIONE SENTIMENTO ROMEO & JULIET - £29

Famiglia Pasqua, Italy. A rare blend of indigenous Valpolicella grape varieties and Merlot made in a Ripasso style give an extra depth of sweetness and flavour to this lip smacking juicy red. Warning: You may fall in love with it.

### CARMENERE - £29.5

Armador, Chile. Notable aromas include dark chocolate and blackberry with hints of coffee and liquorice. Great with spicy food.

### SHIRAZ/CABERNET - £35

Some Young Punks, Australia. A rich mouthful of lip-smacking, sensuously structured McLaren Cabernet and Clare Shiraz. Plumes of tannins, that hang about like seagulls around hot chips (but in a much more amorous way).

### TEMPRANILLO - £22

Campo Flores, Spain. Certified Organic. Zero oak ageing gives you an easy drinking red with hints of juicy ripe strawberries and blackcurrant.
